

DETAILED SCORING SYSTEM

STAGE 1 – ROUND II:

§ 1.

The position on the ranking list is determined by the number of points awarded to the student for the categories listed in § 10 Item 8 of The Rules.

§ 2.

The number of points constituting the place on the ranking list (L) is calculated according to the following formula:

$$L = \sum L_n$$

where the meaning of each symbol is as follows:

L – Number of ranking points obtained by a student;

L_n - Points for categories listed in § 10 Item 8 of The Rules.

§ 3.

The scoring system:

SYMBOL	TYPE	NUMBER OF POINTS
n1	2nd year of 1st degree uniform master's degree studies (year of studies in the following academic year)	200 pts
n2	3rd year of 1st degree uniform master's degree studies (year of studies in the following academic year)	300 pts
n3	4th year of 1st degree uniform master's degree studies / 1st year of 2nd degree uniform master's degree studies (year of studies in the following academic year)	400 pts
n4	5th year of 1st degree uniform master's degree studies / 2nd year of 2nd degree uniform master's degree studies (year of studies in the following academic year)	500 pts

n5	Residence in a Student Dormitory in the previous academic year	250 pts
n6	Light disability	100 pts
n7	Moderate disability	200 pts
n8	Significant disability	300 pts
n9	Half-orphan	100 pts
n10	Orphan	200 pts
n11	Raised in a children's home or foster care	100 pts
n12	The distance from the place of residence to the registered office of the Faculty (up to 500 points)	1 pt. per 1 km

STAGE II:**§ 4.**

The position on the ranking list is determined by the number of points awarded to a person admitted to the University in two categories:

- 1) Points obtained for the recruitment procedure;
- 2) Points obtained for the categories listed in § 11 Item 8 of The Rules.

§ 5.

The number of points constituting the place on the ranking list (L) is calculated according to the following formula:

$$L = L_o + \sum L_n$$

where the meaning of each symbol is as follows:

L – Number of ranking points obtained by a student;

L_o – Number of points obtained in the recruitment process;

L_n - Points for other categories.

§ 6.

Points obtained for the recruitment procedure:

- 1) In the case of persons admitted to first-cycle and unified master's degree programs, the points obtained in the recruitment procedure are multiplied $\times 10$;
- 2) in the case of persons admitted to the second degree program, number of points is calculated on the basis of the grade obtained on the diploma according to the following conversion:
 - a) 5.0 – 1000 points,
 - b) 4.5 – 750 points,
 - c) 4.0 – 500 points,
 - d) 3.5 – 250 points,
 - e) 3.0 – 0 points.

Points for the remaining categories:

n8	A difficult material situation of the family (net income per person not exceeding the income entitling to financial aid)	200 pts
n9	The distance from the place of residence to the registered office of the Faculty (up to 500 points)	1 pt. for 1 km
